Individually tailored workshops to help

The Family Centre's two-hour workshop is designed to educate school and daycare staff to confidently support a student with type 1 diabetes. Every child has a different diabetes regimen, so each workshop is individually tailored to upskill educators to meet the specific needs of the child in their care.

We cover the key areas of a student's Diabetes Management and Action Plan, working with parents first to develop practical, hands-on information sessions that build teachers' skills and confidence.

Delivered by Alia Parker, who is an experienced educator and a parent of two children with type 1 diabetes, this workshop will leave your school staff well equipped to help their type 1 diabetic students to shine.

Schools and Daycare Education is delivered in two formats for schools to choose from:

- A one-hour general presentation to all school staff, followed by a one-hour small group session (up to 6 staff) to educate key teachers in the practical tasks and skills they need, including blood glucose monitoring, using bolus calculators, and carb counting.
- A two-hour intensive small group workshop with the student's key teachers and school staff (up to 6) that provides in-depth diabetes management education combined with practical skills training.
