Flametree Winery and Cellar Door is located at the gateway to the Margaret River wine region, on the shores of Geographe Bay.

Flametree, owned by the Towner family, has had extraordinary success since its first vintage in 2007. The usual practice of planting a vineyard and then finding someone to make the wine was turned on its head: a state-of-the-art winery was built, and grape purchase agreements signed with growers in the region. Show success was topped by the winning of the Jimmy Watson Trophy¹ with its '07 Cabernet Merlot². If all this were not enough, Flametree has secured the services of winemaker Cliff Royle.

An effective fundraiser


